In 2002

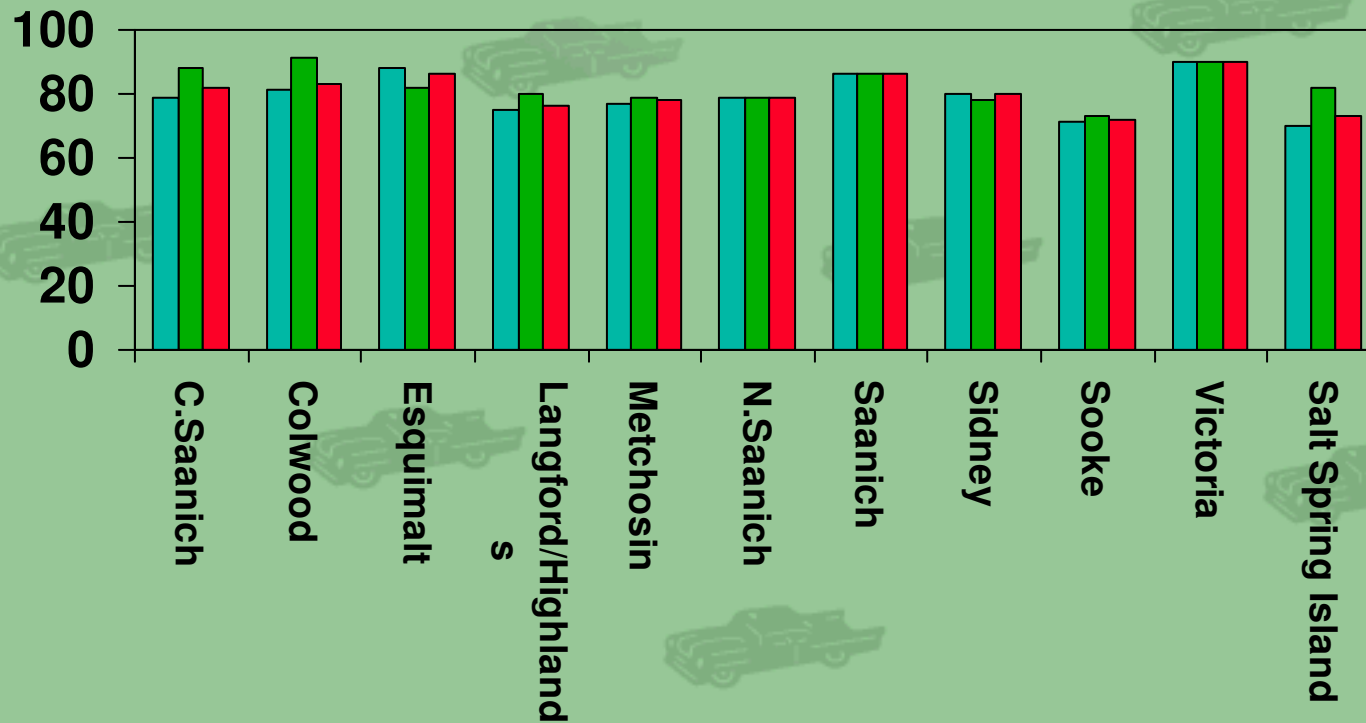
- Rate for Vancouver Island = 84%

Seatbelt Facts

- For every 1% increase in provincial wearing rates, ICBC claims figures could decrease as much as \$3 million.
